Conditions for the acceptance of your trained service dog in the cabin

KLM recommends you to request transport of your trained service dog at least 48 hours before departure. Please contact KLM CARES for questions and additional information. The restrictions on traveling with animals can differ per country. You are responsible for arranging any necessary formalities.

Trained service dogs must behave correctly in public and immediately follow the instructions of their owners. If this is not the case, you may be asked for details of the training and behavior of the trained service dog. If your trained service dog does not behave properly, it can be refused in the cabin. The trained service dog must wear a (car) harness and be secured to your seatbelt during the entire flight.

Trained service dogs are not allowed on the seat. Your trained service dog should fit on the floor in front of your own seat and may not impede the legroom of another passenger, aisle or emergency exit. If there is no suitable space to accommodate a large trained service dog in the cabin, the trained service dog can be transported in the hold at no extra charge (provided you have an appropriate and suitable kennel present).
